“ I'm so very sorry to hear about Antone. I'm a professor at the College of Charleston, and I had the great fortune of interacting with Antone weekly, if not daily, for many years. He always had a warm smile, was generous with his time, was curious about others, and was so easy to talk to. I remember taking my son, Sam, to CofC with me one day when he was about 1. I was carrying him up the steps in 9 College Way when we ran into Antone. Sam was a little shy initially but Antone got him to warm up quickly. Antone always asked about Sam after that day. A few years later, after Sam had been diagnosed with brain cancer in 2013, I was on campus again and ran into Antone. I was really shaken by my son's diagnosis; I was a shell of myself. When Antone asked me how Sam was doing, I told him the truth. Antone was visibly moved. I was on leave from the College for several years while my family and I cared for our son before he died in 2016. I hadn't seen Antone for three years. When I returned to campus, I ran into Antone pretty quickly, and he immediately asked, "How's your son?" He had such care in his voice and genuine concern on his face. I told Antone the bad news, and shared a powerful moment in Sam's memory.

Antone was a wonderful person, and I am so fortunate to have known him.
