Ezell G. Middleton was born October 13, 1942 to Janie Mae Green in Yemassee, SC. She entered into eternal rest on Sunday, March 16, 2025. Sis. Middleton earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Shaw University in 1983, fusing her knowledge, wisdom, and giftedness to help others for over 30 years at Baptist Hill High School in the Charleston County School District before retiring. Mrs. Middleton was beloved and known for her passion to enrich the lives of all she came in contact with including faculty, staff and most importantly, students. She was very active civically and politically, serving 5 consecutive terms on Hollywood's Town Council and as Mayor Pro Tem amassing 21 years of governmental service. Improving her community was one of her core values demonstrated by the many years she hosted the Summer Free Lunch program at her home and her volunteer work at the Covenant House for at-risk teen girls. After retiring from the educational system, she went on to work for the Roper St. Francis Hospital network where she served as a Triage Administrator ensuring patients received the best quality care in a timely manner. There she retired after serving 20 years. In her professional career and Christian service, she received countless awards and citations for excellent and diligent service at the city, county, state and national levels. She was a pillar in her community. Whether educationally, politically, medically, or communally, her work was not in vain as evidenced by the fruit of her labor. Sis. Ezell was an active member and Sister of the Boaz Chapter #366 of Order of Eastern Star since 1975 and of the Gamma Xi

Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha, Sorority Inc. since 1984.

She is survived by her 3 sons; Benjamin Gadsden, Jr. (Gilma), Rodney Gadsden (Janet) and Darrell Gadsden (Isabell); 1 Daughter; Leah Brown (Chad); 6 grandchildren; Branden Gadsden (Germaine), Raven Gadsden-Washington (Rae); Taylor Gadsden; Marcus Gadsden, Sierra Gadsden, Kodjo Basse Gadsden; 1 great grandchild; Major Washington, one godson, Eric Middleton and a host of cousins that were like brothers and sisters.

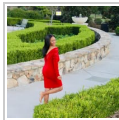
